What happens next?

1. Please download the application form from the CAH website www.Christian-adventure-holidays.org.uk complete it and post it together with a cheque for the non returnable deposit of £100.00 to:-

Please send a cheque, not cash, and cheques should be made out to: -
Christian Adventure Holidays.

Please note that we will not accept applications that arrive before Thursday 1st December 2011.

Applications that arrive before this date will be put to the back of the processing queue on that day.

2. We will send you an acknowledgement of your application by e-mail early in 2012. *(please write very clearly your e-mail address on the application form)(Please check your spam file as the email may be classed as spam)*
3. From 1st March 2012 we will place more information and medical forms on the website for you to download, complete and return with a cheque for the balance of £105.00. These must reach us by **April 30th 2012** at the latest. Please note that *medical forms are as important as the payment* and must be returned with the payment.

The final payment is non returnable once paid. In the event of a cancellation that is made close to the holiday, we will try to find a child to fill the place, in that event we may, at our discretion, give a partial refund of the final payment. You may consider taking out holiday insurance to cover possible cancellations.

The cost of the holiday is £205.00. We would like to point out again, that the cost of the holiday is subsidised by Christian Outdoor Pursuits Trust (The Registered Charity and Trust responsible for Bassenfell Manor), without this, the cost would be significantly higher.

If there is more than one child attending this years CAH holiday from your family, the second payment can be reduced to £80.00 (£180.00 in total) for all the children attending from your immediate family.

Appreciating the current difficult economic conditions we face, if the cost of the holiday genuinely prevents you being able to send your child on a CAH Holiday, please call Barbara Collett on 01302 771817 and discuss the situation. Through the generosity of others, funding may be available.

We should advise that transport is **not** provided to and from the venue at the beginning and end of each week.

During the weeks, many of the youngsters have great fun in taking photographs of themselves and their friends, which could then be displayed on the CAH web site and other social network sites. Should you **not** wish your child's photo to appear on these web sites, please indicate by placing a tick in the appropriate box on the application form.

Along with other Holiday organisations, we feel that we should make you aware that Christian Adventure Holidays reserve the right to refuse any application or to ask a young person to leave the holiday if their behaviour is incompatible with the general enjoyment and well being of others. In such cases the parent or guardian will be informed and collection arrangements must be made at their own expense. No refunds will be given.

Mobile phones; We strongly suggest that you **do not** let your child bring a mobile phone with them. First of all we have found that they frequently disrupt the smooth running of the holiday programme. Secondly, in the event of homesickness, they make this worse, not better. Thirdly it should be noted that some weeks of our holidays prohibit their use. Finally, in the unfortunate event of an accident we are required by the authorities to control the outflow of any information to ensure that it is accurate and true. If children have mobiles with them on the holiday there is a strong risk that we will not be able comply with this requirement, and parents may be given inaccurate and disturbing information unnecessarily.

Our leaders do have permission to ban their use and even when they are permitted we expect them to be switched off and stored securely except at designated times.

We must also be advised at the time of booking if the young person has any known illness or disability, or currently has, or has recently experienced any behavioural, or social problems which may affect their own safety and/or the well being of others at CAH holidays.

CAH is a voluntary non profit organisation, and everyone associated with it acts on a voluntary basis, although Activity leaders are qualified to nationally recognised outdoor pursuits industry standards. Because we all have other commitments, we will answer any queries as soon as we can, but it is not always possible for us to reply immediately.

Finally, please note that we have asked you to indicate which week you require and the possible alternatives weeks you could accept, should your preferred week be full at the time of processing your application. Do this by placing a 1 in your preferred week box and 2,3 etc., in the other weeks that may be acceptable to you.

We trust that the Holidays in 2012 will be as successful as those in past years and ask for your prayers for safety and blessings for our young people.
